

I have an extensive career in anesthesiology. I completed his residency in the Department of Anesthesiology at Dokkyo Medical University Hospital from 1992 to 1993, followed by postgraduate studies at Dokkyo Medical University from 1994 to 1998. I served as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Anesthesiology at Dokkyo Medical University from 1998 to 2000 and then as a Postdoctoral Fellow at Johns Hopkins University from 2000 to 2002. I returned to Dokkyo Medical University as an Associate Professor from 2002 to 2006 and later became the Director of the Palliative Care Unit at Dokkyo Medical University Hospital from 2006 to 2012. Since 2012, I have been a Professor and Chairman of the Department of Anesthesiology at Dokkyo Medical School. Additionally, I was a Visiting Professor at the Institute for Environmental and Gender Specific Medicine at Juntendo University from 2013 to 2019 and a Visiting Assistant Professor at the Department of Anesthesiology and Medical Crisis Management at Nagoya City University from 2014 to 2020. I am currently the president of Japan Society of Pain Clinicians.
